Key Stage 1

- Questions about God: How do Christian's ideas about God compare with my own?
- Family Ties: How and why do Hindus celebrate Raksha Bandhan?

Lower Key Stage 2

- Prayer: How and why do Muslims and Jews pray?
- Peace: Why should we give it a chance? Light and Dark: What do these symbols mean?
- Belief through Art: How do people express their spiritual ideas through art? (this can be covered by Y 5/6)

Upper Key Stage 2

- The Journey of Life: What happens when we die?
- Whose World Is It?
- How was the world created and why should I care about it today?
- Milestones and Meaning: How does Bar/Bat Mitzvah affect the life of a Jewish child and their family?
- Belief through Art: How do people express their spiritual ideas through art? (this can be covered by Y 3/4)
