Phonics

Phonics Early phonic sessions will take place next term. This term we will be playin listening games to enhance listening skills and concentration

Literacy

This term we will be listening to nursery rhymes and stories and begin to look at, read and share books together both in small groups and as a class. We will be encouraging the children to recognise some familiar story characters along the way. Sounds within our own environment will also be of focus.



Maths

In Maths we will be singing and taking part in Number songs to 5, exploring the concept of big and small and subitising amounts to 3.

Communication and language

We will encourage the children to listen and make comments about their learning. Also encourage then to express their ideas and feelings using full understandable sentences.

We will continue to support the children to make positive relationships and help them to settle into new Nursery routines.
