



Spring



<p>Topic</p> 	<p>To know how Easter is celebrated. To plant and care for a sunflower and to know and describe its life cycle. Vocab: plant, grow, seed, water, sunlight</p>
<p>Literacy</p> 	 <p>To begin to know how a story is structured. Vocab: beginning, middle, end</p>
<p>Maths</p>	 <p>To be able to order two or more objects by their length. Vocab: biggest, tallest, smallest, shortest, middle sized, medium</p> <p>To recognise numerals 1-5</p> 
<p>Physical</p>	<p>To know and name some different types of food, especially fruit and vegetables.</p>
<p>Art</p>	<p>To explore clay and to know how to manipulate it to create a flower.</p>

<p>Topic</p>	<p>To know the life cycle of a butterfly. To know what a minibeast is and where to find them. Vocab: egg, caterpillar, chrysalis, butterfly, life cycle</p>	
<p>Literacy</p>	<p>To sequence a familiar story. Vocab: first, then, next, last</p>	<p>To suggest how a story might end. Vocab: ending, action, event</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>To begin to use the language of 'more' and 'fewer' to compare two sets of objects. To describe a familiar route, using 'landmarks' to do so.</p>	
<p>Physical</p>	<p>To begin to know what makes a balanced diet and why we have a range of different food types.</p>	
<p>Art</p>	<p>To study the artwork of Eric Carle and create their own picture in his style.</p>
